Q: How/where can one apply for affordable living space or rehearsal space via AREA?

A: If you believe your organization meets the AREA requirements as artist workspace developers and operators, you may submit your application as detailed in <u>Part 4. Process and Procedure</u> of the RFEI. All RFEI responses and supporting documentation are to be submitted by hand or by mail to NYCEDC. The package must contain eight (8) hard copies and two USB drives each containing one digital copy to the following addresses:

Q: Are utilities included in the \$1.50 per square foot rent requirement?

A: Yes, utilities are included in the set \$1.50 per square foot rent ceiling. AREA affordability is defined by limiting monthly occupancy cost (including but not limited to tenant's rent, tenant's share of operating expense, tenant's share of utilities, and tenant's share of capital reserve contribution) to \$1.50 per square foot.

The AREA affordable rent shall be adjusted each year for the duration of term to reflect change in the Consumer Price Index or other market condition.
