

**WRITTEN CONSENT OF  
THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

The undersigned, as a member of the Board of Trustees of The Trust for Cultural Resources of The City of New York, a New York public benefit corporation (the "Trust"), acting without a meeting pursuant to Section 20.09(4) of the Arts and Cultural Affairs Law of the State of New York, does hereby consent to the following resolutions:

**WHEREAS**, on or before October 31, 2022, the Trust is required pursuant to the Public Authorities Accountability Act and related statutes to post in the Public Authorities Reporting Information System ("PARIS") a Budget and Financial Plan (the "PARIS Budget"), showing (a) Actual Receipts and Expenditures for 2021, (b) Current Estimated Receipts and Expenditures for 2022, (c) Receipts and Expenditures Adopted by the Board of Trustees for 2023, and (d) Proposed Receipts and Expenditures for 2024-2026;

**WHEREAS**, the New York City Economic Development Corporation ("EDC") has prepared the PARIS Budget in the prescribed format;

**WHEREAS**, approval by the Trust of a further extension through December 31, 2023 of the Second Amended and Restated Agreement dated as of January 1, 2020 between the Trust and EDC, which has a current expiration date of December 31, 2022, is necessary and appropriate for the continuation of the Trust's normal operations;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, it is hereby

**RESOLVED**, that the PARIS Budget be, and hereby is, approved, and the posting of the PARIS Budget be, and hereby is, authorized; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that the extension through December 31, 2023 of the Second Amended and Restated Agreement dated as of January 1, 2020 between the Trust and the New York City Economic Development Corporation be, and hereby is, authorized.

**This resolution shall take effect immediately upon the receipt by the Secretary of the Trust of the written consent of all members of the Board of Trustees of the Trust.**
