World Casing Corporation receives animal intestines (casings) from all over the world. These casings are processed/further processed in to a saleable form to be used in the manufacturing of sausage products. The casings arrive in a salted form in drums. They then go for processing.

This processing is a primarily manual operation. The casings are graded and cut for size and quality. This process requires washing the casings to rinse off the salt and to soften the product. Each individual piece of casing must be flushed with water and graded in to various categories based on the diameter and quality of the product.

This process is repeated for each piece of casing. The casings are then measured in to saleable units called hanks. Being sheared onto plastic tubes then further processes these hanks, which is then used for easy application by the sausage maker. The next process is packaging where the casings are salted and prepared for shipping. The sausage industry has demanded to receive casings in a "ready to stuff" state. As a result, further processing is required by the casing supplier to satisfy their needs.
