Kingsbridge Armory features:

A \$200M Investment

Governor Hochul and Mayor Adams have announced a \$200 million City-State investment toward the redevelopment of the Kingsbridge Armory and the fulfillment of the "Together for Kingsbridge Vision Plan," to create goodpaying, local jobs that build economic opportunity and improve the quality of life for people in Kingsbridge Heights and neighboring Bronx communities. Backed by the \$200 million City-State investment, the plan will inform a forthcoming request for proposals (RFP) for the redevelopment of the Kingsbridge Armory.



Premier Location

With over 14 million people living within a one-hour drive, Kingsbridge Armory has excellent transportation access via:

- 4 train station next to the Armory on Jerome Avenue
- B/D train
- Metro-North station at Fordham, serviced by Harlem and New Haven Lines
- Major Deegan Expressway

Kingsbridge Armory is also excellently situated in the Kingsbridge Heights neighborhood, home to:

- A large number of educational institutions including CUNY Lehman and Fordham University
- A cluster of primary, middle, and high schools on Reservoir Avenue, known in the neighborhood as "Educational Mile"
- Key health and life sciences facilities such as the James
 J. Peters Department of Veterans Affairs Medical Center
 and the Montefiore Medical Center Moses Campus

As a C4-zoned, NYC Landmark site, the Armory's permitted uses include:

- Office
- Retail
- Film & TV (including sound stages)
- Theaters (live and motion picture)
- Community facilities
