Project Overview

Location

- 61 acres (23 of which are City-owned) situated between Corona & Flushing
- Proximity to 7 train, LIRR, major highways, LaGuardia Airport, Citi Field, & Flushing Meadows Corona Park

Opportunities

- Creation of a new mixed-use, mixed-income community
- Cleanup of the area and surrounding waterways
- Place to live and work as well as a destination for visitors
- Generator of economic growth for Queens







Phase 1

Development Program

- 1M SF across 6 acres
- 1,100 units of 100% affordable housing, including 220 units designated for seniors
- 650-seat elementary school
- 1.2 acres of open space
- Neighborhood-serving retail and community facility space
- New streets
- New infrastructure along 126th St, Willets Point Blvd, & within the Phase 1 site
- Remediation commenced June 2021

Next Milestones

- Remediation: 2021-2023
- Infrastructure construction period: 2022-2024
- Affordable housing construction start: Approximately 2024
- School site delivered to SCA for construction: Approximately 2024



Willets Point OU-1/Phase 1 – Selected Remedy



Willets Point OU-1/Phase 1 Remedy

Department of Environmental Conservation's (DEC) hierarchy of remedy selection:

- 1. Removal
- Treatment
- 3. Containment

How was the remedy chosen?

- Remedial Alternatives Analysis incorporating:
 - 2 Threshold Criteria and 6 Balancing Criteria

Which remedy was selected for Willets Point OU-1/Phase 1?

- Combination of containment and removal with a treatment contingency
- Remedy began in June 2021 and is substantially complete as of March 2022

Willets Point OU-1 Remedy – Removal of Source Areas, Shallow Excavation, and Containment

Removal


- Entire site subject to a minimum 2-foot excavation of continuous historic fill
- Deeper petroleum source removal

Containment

 Installation of a groundwater containment cutoff wall to prevent migration of petroleum contaminated groundwater

CONCEPTUAL ILLUSTRATION OF A GROUNDWATER CONTAINMENT CUTOFF SHEET PILE WALL





Willets Point Remediation and Regulatory Progress (OU-2) Remedial Investigation and Regulatory Update:

- RIWP Addendum Report Approved
- Remedial Investigation Complete
 - Soil Borings (Proposed 205/Completed 228)
 - Monitoring Wells (Proposed 45/Completed 47)
 - Soil Vapor Points (Proposed 45/Completed 44)
- Remedial Investigation Report Submitted to NYSDEC January 4, 2022
- Remedial Action Work Plan Submitted to NYSDEC February 25, 2022
 - 45-day public comment period anticipated to begin in April 2022

Willets Point Remediation and Regulatory Progress (OU-2)

Remedial Investigation Report - Preliminary Summary

OU-2 compared to OU-1

- OU-2 findings were as expected and similar to findings at OU-1. Main differences include:
 - Chlorinated solvent-related contamination <u>not</u> observed in groundwater at OU-2
 - 1,4-dioxane (solvent stabilizer) observed at lesser concentrations in groundwater than OU-1

OU-2 Summary

- Site-wide Historic Fill: coal ash layer, various debris, lead and chromium detected at concentrations above the U.S. EPA Maximum Concentration of Contaminants for the Toxicity Characteristic
- Petroleum-related Contamination in Soil, Groundwater, and/or Soil Vapor
 - Observed onsite during investigation via visual staining and odors
 - Confirmed via analytical testing
- Chlorinated-related Contamination Soil Vapor in limited/localized areas
- Methane is present site-wide in Soil Vapor



Willets Point Remediation and Regulatory Progress (OU-2)

Remedial Action Update:

- Interim Remedial Measure Work Plan Approved
- Interim Remedial Measures Product recovery on Block 1826 is ongoing
- Remedial Action Work Plan Submitted to NYSDEC on February 25, 2022; public comment period anticipated to begin April 13.
