Onsite parking

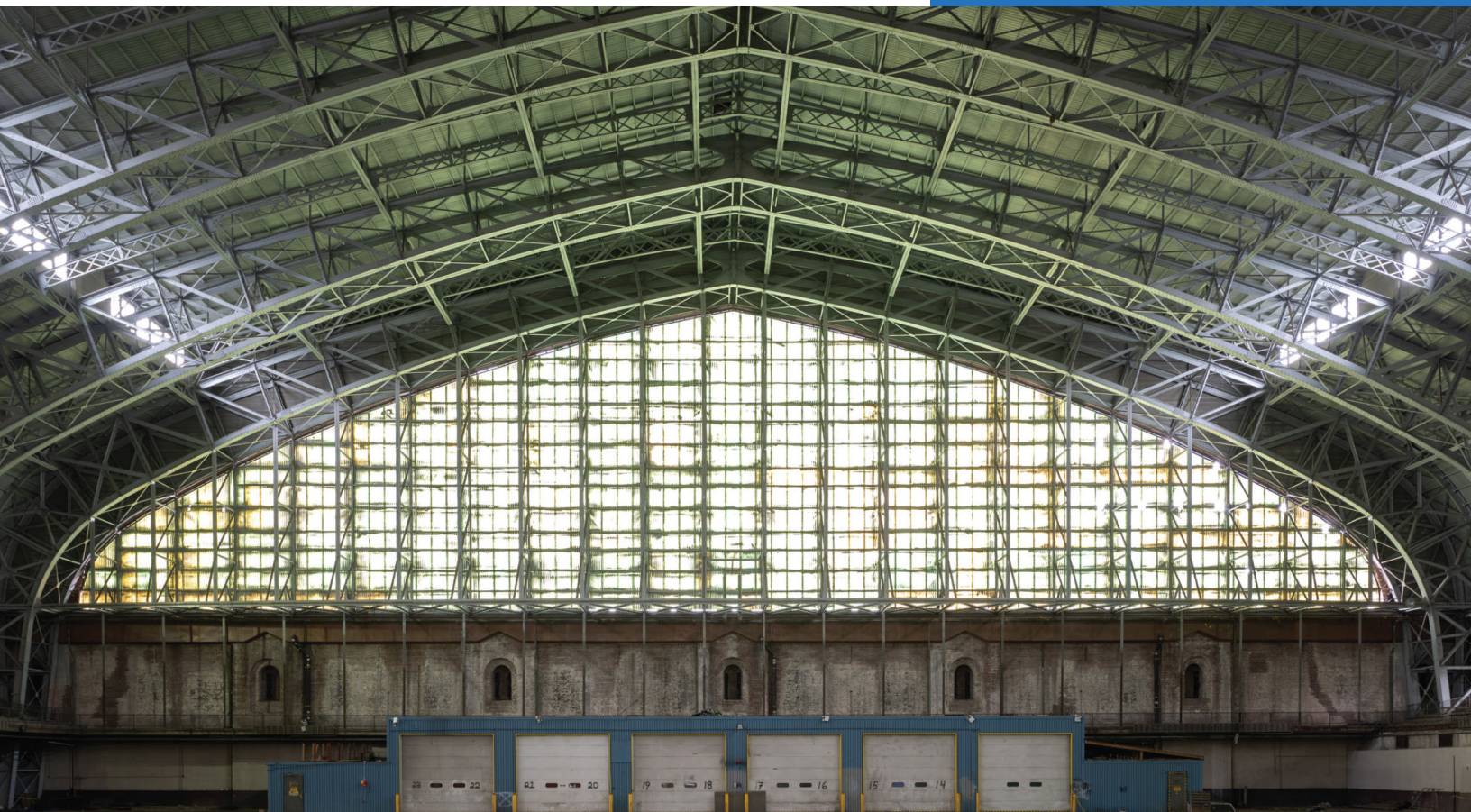

The History

Opened in 1917, the **Kingsbridge Armory** was used for military parades and exercises in the first half of the 20th century. **Designated as an NYC Landmark** in 1974, the Armory was listed on the New York State and National Register of Historical Places in 1982 and was transferred to the City in 1996.



Short-Term Usage Opportunities: Film, TV, and More

As one of the largest indoor spaces in New York City, the Kingsbridge Armory is an exceptional venue to host a wide range of multimedia productions including:

- Film and TV shoots
- Fashion shoots
- Live music events
- Sports
- Conferences
- Rodeos
- Runway shows
- Trade exhibitions

Most recently, the Armory served as a shooting location for Amazon Prime's smash series *The Marvelous Mrs. Maisel* and Max's *The Penguin*. Movie studio space could build on these successes, taking advantage of the expansive drill hall—**able to accommodate multiple sets at once**—while preserving the architectural significance of the open space and arches.

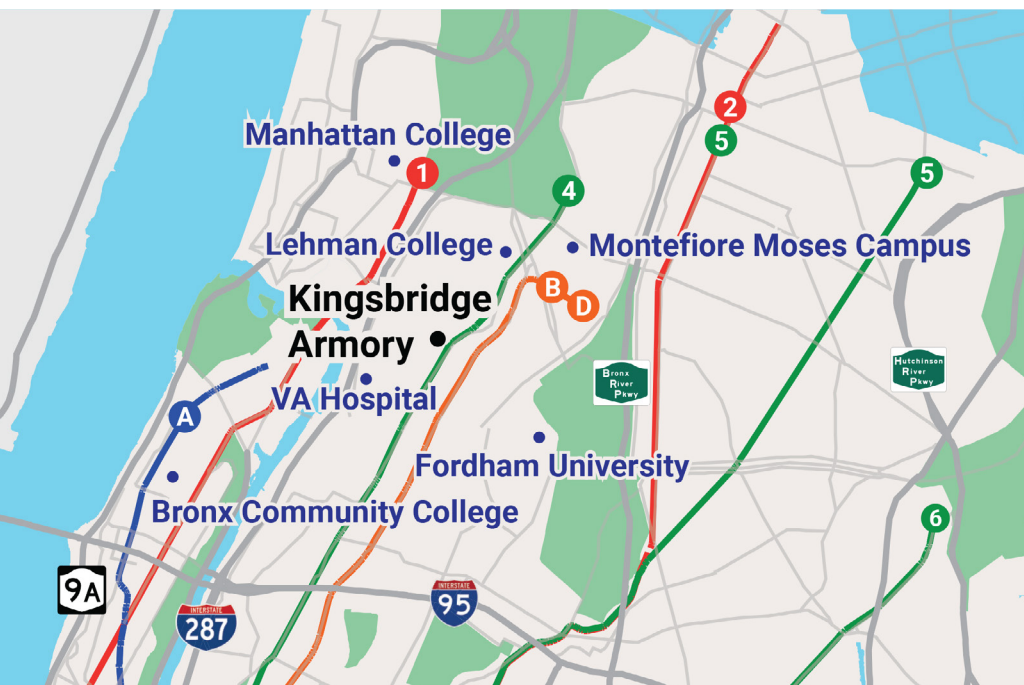
Premier Location

Kingsbridge Armory has excellent transportation access via:

- 4 train
- B/D train
- Metro-North station at Fordham, serviced by Harlem and New Haven Lines

Kingsbridge Armory is also excellently situated in the Kingsbridge Heights neighborhood, home to:

- A cluster of educational institutions including CUNY Lehman and Fordham University
- Key health and life sciences facilities such as the James J. Peters Department of Veterans Affairs Medical Center and the Montefiore Medical Center Moses Campus
