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1. Introduction and Objective

At the request of JrCruz Corp. (Contractor) and on behalf of New York City Economic Development Corporation (NYCEDC) (hereinafter referred to as “applicant”), Applemon Corporation (Applemon), developed the Public Participation Plan (plan) for the proposed New Stapleton Waterfront Northern and Southern Phase project in Staten Island, New York (NYCEDC Contract No: 59530002-01) to comply with the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) Commissioner Policy-29, Environmental Justice and Permitting (CP-29). The purpose of the plan was to address environmental justice concerns and ensure public participation in the DEC environmental permit review process by the impacted community. This Summary Report documents the implementation and completion of all activities pursuant to the plan which had been approved by the DEC on July 2, 2024 in support of the NYCEDC's SPDES permit application.

2. Project Description

The applicant proposes to construct storm and sanitary sewers, and water mains on Front Street from Wave Street to Hannah Street as part of the New Stapleton Waterfront Redevelopment Project for revitalization of Stapleton area in Staten Island, New York. To implement the proposed project, the applicant has submitted applications to the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) for SPDES and Water Withdrawal permit(s) to install and operate a temporary construction dewatering and groundwater treatment system for the withdrawal and discharge of up to 1.008 MGD of treated groundwater.

The project site is located along public right of way on the northeast corner of Staten Island. The sewer excavation area that requires dewatering consists of an approximately 2000-ft long corridor on Front Street shown on Figure 1. The project site consists of paved roadway. It is approximately 400 feet away from Hudson River. The maximum excavation depth for construction of the sewers is approximately 17 feet below grade



surface (bgs). The topography in the area surrounding the site consists of relatively flat to mild slopes associated with series of low hills and valleys flattened during urbanization of the area. The site's elevation is approximately 8 feet above the Borough of Richmond Sewer Datum which is 3.192 feet above mean sea level. The site is within an area that is primarily characterized by mixed commercial and industrial development.

As shown on Figure 1, temporary dewatering to facilitate the installation of the sewers and water mains will be required during construction. For dewatering during construction of the sewers and water mains, approximately 40 dewatering wells will be installed in the silty and sandy overburden to collect groundwater from the construction site and discharge it into existing storm sewers after passing through a pretreatment system to remove settleable solids and chemical contamination, where necessary. Given the size and the locations of the project site, the dewatering area is divided into two (2) segments and two (2) points of discharge (POD) are designated for the project. Only one POD will be active at a time. POD1 will carry dewatering flow from Segment 1 and discharge it into an existing 48" storm sewer crossing Front Street (Murray Hulbert Avenue) along Swan Street. This sewer discharges to New York Upper Bay through NYCDEP MS4 Outfall no. PR-622. POD2 will carry dewatering flow from Segment 2 and discharge it into an existing double barrel 74"x42" CSO sewer crossing Front Street (Murray Hulbert Avenue) along Baltic Street. This sewer discharges to New York Upper Bay through NYCDEP CSO Outfall no. PR-014. Header pipes will convey groundwater from individual wells to the settling tank and the pretreatment system. The discharge from the tank or the pretreatment system will enter the existing storm sewers using a temporary hard connection. A maximum of three (3) pumps at 160 gpm each for POD 1 and a total maximum of four (4) pumps at 175 gpm each for POD2 will be used at one time for a period of 2 years to facilitate this operation. The dewatering pumps will be relocated with project progress.



3. Stakeholders and Contact List

Per DEC's recommendations and in consultation and collaboration with Staten Island Community Board 1, NYCEDC, and PM/CM LiRo-Hill, a contact list of interested and affected parties was developed (see Appendix A). The list included local government and elected officials; business owners, residents, and occupants; local civic, community, environmental and religious organizations; local news media; administrator/operator of any school that live, work and/or represent a neighborhood or community within a 500-foot radius. This contact list was utilized by the applicant to communicate and disseminate information about the project and the permit application review process with the affected community and stakeholders.

4. Public Outreach Activities

In accordance with the approved PPP, the applicant utilized a range of outreach activities to facilitate participation, involvement, and direct communication with the affected community. The applicant: 1) published and disseminated the fact sheet (in both English and Spanish); 2) published and circulated the public meeting notice (in both English and Spanish) encouraging the affected community and stakeholders to attend an online public meeting; 3) conducted a virtual public meeting on Thursday, July 18, 2024 at 6:30 pm. See sections 4.1 and 4.2 below for more details about these activities.

4.1 Public Meeting Notice and Fact Sheet

- The public meeting notices (Appendix B) were published in El Diario and Staten Island Advance on July 3 and 9, 2024 (see Appendix D).
- The public meeting notices and fact sheets were mailed to the entire list of stakeholders and contact list (Appendix A) on July 3, 2024 (see Appendix D).
- The public meeting notices and fact sheets were posted within the vicinity of the project site and visible to the public (see Appendix D).

4.2 Public Meeting

In coordination with NYCEDC (applicant), LiRo-Hill (project manager), and JrCruz (contractor), Applemon facilitated the virtual public meeting on Thursday July 18, 2024 at 6:30pm. Applemon presented an overview of the overall construction project, project background, reasons for dewatering, areas of concerns, scope of dewatering work, community impact, dewatering treatment system, SPDES permit application, and contact information. Twenty two people attended the meeting (see Appendix E).

The public meeting included a dedicated Q&A portion where the floor was open for attendees to ask questions, make remarks, and/or express concerns. The attendees raised the following questions during the Q&A:

Question 1 - Why is there a difference in pretreatment system for POD1 and POD2?

Question 2 - Which CSO outfall is POD2 discharging from?

Question 3 – Will the monthly samples be publicly available?

Question 4 - What were the identified contaminants on southern end portion of the project?

Question 5 – For any questions about access/closure of the bay who to ask?

Applemon responded to all questions about the dewatering. It was explained that the dewatering area is divided into two segments and two points of discharge (POD) are designated for the project given the size and location of the project. The results of groundwater samples at Segment 1 did not include any contamination; however, tetrachloroethylene (perc) and lead were identified at levels in excess of NYSDEC's water quality standards at Segment 2. Therefore, for POD1, the pretreatment system includes a settling tank to remove settleable solids. For POD2, the pretreatment system includes settling tank, microfiltration and activated carbon filters to remove the chemical



contamination in addition to removing settleable solids. POD1 will carry dewatering flow from Segment 1 and discharge it into an existing 48” storm sewer crossing Front Street (Murray Hulbert Avenue) along Swan Street. This sewer discharges to New York Upper Bay through NYCDEP MS4 Outfall no. PR-622. POD2 will carry dewatering flow from Segment 2 and discharge it into an existing double barrel 74”x42” CSO sewer crossing Front Street (Murray Hulbert Avenue) along Baltic Street. This sewer discharges to New York Upper Bay through NYCDEP CSO Outfall no. PR-014.

Attendees were advised to contact the project liaison (John Caropreso; 450 Front St., Staten Island, NY 10304; Phone: (347) 265-9220; CaropresoJ@LiRo-Hill.com) for any questions about the project including information about access to the Bay and road closure during the construction and obtaining any project documents including the discharge monitoring reports. The contact information for the project liaison was announced multiple times during the public meeting.

No further questions or comments about the dewatering activities and permit application were raised. Attendees were also informed of how they may submit formal comments on the permit application to the DEC and obtain answers to questions after the meeting has concluded.

5. Document Repository

An online document repository has been established for the community to access the information about the project. The online repository available at <https://edc.nyc/project/new-stapleton-waterfront> provides information and documents relating to the project and the SPDES permit application such as the Public Participation Plan, public notices and fact sheets. The repository will be updated throughout the application process with project-related information and written materials (i.e., draft permit, statement of basis (where applicable), the Notice of Complete Application provided by the NYSDEC, etc.).

What is the Proposed Project?

The proposed project will improve approximately 2000 feet of roadways and construct storm and sanitary sewers and water mains on Front Street from Wave Street to Hannah Street as part of the New Stapleton Waterfront Redevelopment Project for revitalization of Stapleton area in Staten Island. To implement the proposed project, water withdrawal is required during sewer excavation. Therefore, New York City Economic Development Corporation (NYCEDC) has submitted an application to the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC) for dewatering and groundwater pumping operations, which requires a New York State Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (SPDES) permit.

Why does NYCEDC need to upgrade the infrastructure in Staten Island Stapleton Area? The existing utility infrastructure at the site for management of stormwater and sewage generated by the properties within the project site is old, insufficient and dysfunctional. There are no functioning storm sewers within most of the site. Presence of a relatively shallow silt and clay layer in the area has limited the rate of stormwater infiltration and dissipation. This project will provide much needed street drainage for the proposed Project Area. The reconstructed streets and new infrastructure will improve vehicular and pedestrian conditions, while reducing the potential for future flooding impacts and will support neighborhood resiliency with respect to coastal storms, while providing enhanced infrastructure that will support post-storm recovery efforts. Upon completion of this project, storm water within the project area will be properly managed.






