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

- Additional infrastructure upgrades to support the district buildout





Phase 1 126th Street Infrastructure Improvements

AFTER THREE YEARS OF CONSTRUCTION, ALL PHASE 1 INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS ALONG 126TH STREET ARE COMPLETE

October 2023 - April 2024 (New DEP Infrastructure)

- 50-ton, 80-ft long Piles to Support New Water Mains and Sewers
- 20-ft deep Trench Excavations
- New 72-in dia. Trunk Water Main
- New 1520 LF 24-in dia. Sanitary Sewer

November 2024 - April 2025 (New DEP Infrastructure & Road, Curb, & Sidewalk Restoration)

- New 1200 LF Storm Sewer (7.5' x 4.5' Box)
- New 42" Storm Sewer running through Citi Field Lot G
- New Con Edison Feeders for Phase 1 Electrical Connection
- New Verizon / Spectrum Telecommunication Lines
- New 12" Water Main tied into new 72" Trunk Water Main for Improved Water Distribution to Willets Point District
- New Curbs, Sidewalks, Roadways, and Lighting
- Reconstruction of Roosevelt Avenue Intersection
- New Crosswalks, Lighting, and Traffic Signalization











Environmental Remediation Completed

Phase 1 Remediation Completed

- Over 102,000 tons of contaminated soil removed
- Over 29,000 cubic yards of clean fill imported
- 68,751 pounds of groundwater treatment products applied
- About 435 linear feet of groundwater containment wall installed
- 16 underground fuel storage tanks removed

Additional Phase 2 (Former OU-2) Remediation Completed

- Over 67,000 tons of contaminated soil removed
- Over 58,000 cubic yards of clean fill imported
- 12,160 pounds of groundwater treatment products applied
- About 510 linear feet of groundwater containment wall installed
- 22 underground storage tanks removed

Ongoing Work (Monitoring)

- Supplemental groundwater monitoring in L-Parcel (C241146H) April/May 2024
- Quarterly groundwater monitoring next event April 2025
- Vapor mitigation for future and buildings currently under construction
- Long-term protection of remedial elements







Brownfield Cleanup Program Progress

Parcel Configuration and NYSDEC Certificate of Completion Status

- BCP Site Split into 8 parcels to align with future redevelopment parcels
- NYSDEC Brownfield Cleanup Program Closure Documents submitted for all project parcels
- All future site redevelopment to be managed under respective Site Management Plans










Brownfield Cleanup Program Process

Phase 1 Housing Update

Building 1 & 2 (880 100% affordable housing units)


- Broke ground in 4Q 2023
- Over 97% bought-out
- Topping out anticipated in 2Q 2025
- First resident move-ins expected in first half of 2026

Building 3 (220 100% Senior affordable housing units)

- Fully designed; Issued 100% CDs
- Working with NYC agencies to break ground as soon as practicable

















NYCFC Stadium Update

NYCFC Stadium: Progress Update (December 2024 – March 2025)

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- Stadium construction: Making good progress since December groundbreaking, scheduled for 2027 opening
- Completed all 1300+ below ground piles to support the new stadium
- Next phase of work: Underground utilities; excavation and foundation; prep for structural steel (summer 2025)
- Over recent months, Turner and NYCFC hosted:
 - Workforce Expo with construction trade unions on 2.20
 - "She Can Build" pre/apprenticeship event with DC9 on 3.11
 - "Meet the Prime Contractors" event for local and MWBE construction firms on 4.24

 Surrounding infrastructure: Design of all public open space around the stadium, streets and utilities, is largely complete; general contractors AECOM and Turner appointed to begin this work


