

NOTICE OF PUBLIC SCOPING HEARING – The New York City Office of the Deputy Mayor for Housing, Economic Development and Workforce (the lead agency) has determined that the proposed Brooklyn Marine Terminal (BMT) Maritime and Mixed-Use Redevelopment Project may have a significant adverse impact on the environment, and a Draft Environmental Impact Statement must be prepared. Information related to scoping was previously noticed on September 24, 2025 in relation to two public scoping meetings on October 28th and October 30th. The lead agency invites public comment on the Draft Scope of Work (DSOW) and public participation through an additional third scoping meeting. An in-person scoping meeting will be held on Monday, December 1st at 6:00 pm, at Sacred Hearts - St. Stephen Church at 125 Summit Street, Brooklyn NY 11231.
