

NEW YORK CITY INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AGENCY

PROTECTION FOR WHISTLEBLOWERS

Adopted on July 22, 2014

No officer, agent, director, alternate director or employee of New York City Industrial Development Agency (the “Agency”) may retaliate against any officer, agent, director, alternate director or employee of the Agency who makes a good faith report of wrongdoing, misconduct, malfeasance or other inappropriate behavior such as fraud, criminal activity or conflict of interest by an officer, agent, director, alternative director or employee of the Agency by taking an adverse personnel action against the “whistleblower”. Therefore, the “whistleblower” cannot be fired, discharged, demoted, suspended, threatened, harassed or discriminated against as a result of his or her having reported behavior of a type described above to the New York City Department of Investigation (“DOI”), any agent, officer, director, alternate director or employee of the Agency or any governmental body or official.

HOW DO YOU REPORT CORRUPTION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF INVESTIGATION INSPECTOR GENERAL?
